Making Your Presentation

- Presentation time: 25 minutes + 5-10 minutes scientific discussion
- Slide structure:
 - Motivation/problem description
 - Related work
 - Methods
 - Experimental Setup
 - Results
 - Conclusion
- Tips:
 - Slide numbers
 - Last slide as a basis for discussion (no 'thank you' slide)
 - Don't overload slides
 - Label axes of plots
